


Jacquelyn Piro Donovan

With a book by Arthur Laurents, music by Jule Styne and lyrics by Stephen Sondheim, the show comprises a score that features songs that have since become standards, plus, the show helped launch the career of Sondheim. "Everything's Coming Up Roses," "Some People," "Let Me Entertain You," "Together, Wherever We Go" and of course "Rose's Turn" are among the musical's highlights.

Amid a backdrop of the waning days of American vaudeville, Rose urges her daughters into the spotlights where they eventually find their own places and purposes while Rose is left pondering her own life choices.

Since *Gvpsv*'s premiere in 1959 starring the legendary Ethel Merman, the show has enjoyed seemingly endless revivals on Broadway and in

London and remains the gold standard for musical theatre productions. Broadway alone has seen four revivals. all of which have provided a unique take on the musical and its characters.

Much of the show rests on the central casting of Rose, and each actress who takes on the challenge brings something very different to the role.

The original production opened on Broadway on May 21, 1959 at the Broadway Theatre, transferred to the Imperial Theatre, and closed on March 25, 1961. Produced by David Merrick, the production was nominated for 8 Tony Awards® including Best Musical, but did not win a single award. The only award Ms. Merman won for her portrayal of Rose was a Grammy Award® for Best Musical Theatre Album. Subsequent revivals starred Angela Lansbury (1974), Tyne Daly (1989), Bernadette Peters (2003), and Patti LuPone

(2008). A 1962 movie adaptation starred Rosalind Russell, and a 1993 television adaptation starred Bette Midler.

Jacquelyn Piro Donovan will star as Rose, the quintessential stage mother whose own dreams of stardom never materialized. Donovan's performing career launched to an uncommonly early and successful start and before her graduation from Boston University with a fine arts degree, the Boston-born singer and actress had earned her Equity Card. Shortly after, she auditioned for the national tour of Les Misérables and won the role of Cosette. In 1990, Donovan reprised that role in her Broadway debut and in 2002 returned to Broadway and Les Misérables as Cosette's mother Fantine.

Her critically acclaimed 30-year career includes starring in other Broadway productions including Miss Saigon as well as in countless regional and touring company productions. Donovan is also a voice and acting teacher who works with children and has appeared on television shows including the final broadcast of "The Rosie O'Donnell Show."

Donovan previously played the role of Louise in *Gypsy* in the 1990s and returns now as "Momma" Rose. She is the recipient of the Helen Hayes Award for Best Actress for her

portrayal of Lizzie Curry in *110 in the Shade* at the Signature Theatre inWashington, D.C. and is a winner of the Connecticut Critic Circle Award for a performance at the famed Goodspeed Opera House. She recently performed on the "Today" show with Kathie Lee Gifford and Hoda Kotb.

Donovan shared some thoughts about her upcoming role as Rose:

You enjoyed early stage success. Can you relate to Rose's own frustrated attempts to star before adoring audiences?

When I was younger I played Louise so hers was my viewpoint. Now I need to switch my thinking as to why Rose does what she does – to wrap my brain around it. She has a killer instinct – something I had when I got out of school. I was aggressive and so I understand where she came from. But I'm also an empathetic person (in real life) and I'd never push a child the way she does.

Do you find sympathy for Rose despite her overbearingly controlling nature and what do you hope audiences will see in her?

Rose blunders on and is so misguided in her justification for pushing her daughters. She wants a better life for them and for them to succeed. As an actress I was taught that every character is justified in their actions and it's the actor's job to figure out what that justification is. Rose was wronged by her mother, her husbands and her father and so she railroads past everyone. Yet, there is still a softness to her that I hope people see. I'm super delighted to be doing the role.

PART LECTURE. PART SEMINAR. PART PARTICIPATION. PART DISCUSSION Rose seems to lose everything at the end – Herbie and June have gone and Louise has found her own fame. Do you see any reconciliation?

I think Rose and Louise are alike in their ambitions. Rose pushes everyone away except Louise. But I don't think people change their stripes. Rose still has that desire to get something for her daughters that she couldn't get for herself.

Alex More, a struggling actor from Los Angeles, has just been fired from his job at Disney Land, but things are looking up. Alex gets a job as curator for the museum of his idol, Barbra Streisand. Oddly enough, the museum is located in the basement of Streisand's Malibu estate. In the museum are old fashioned Main Street store fronts which house Ms. Streisand's collection of costumes, dolls and trinkets.

In 2010, Ms. Streisand published *My Passion for Design*, an elaborate volume of photos and descriptions of her personal collections which served as inspiration for the storyline of *Buyer & Cellar*.

MAMMA MIA! The Musical Review that Tells a Story **BY ALICE JOHNSON**

Enjoyed by over 60 million people all over the world, Mamma Mia is the wonderful juke box musical that has enjoyed success in 50 countries since opening in 1999. Featuring the music from ABBA, the Swedish pop/dance group from the 1970's and 1980's. Mamma Mia is the fifth longest-running show in London history and the eighth-longest on Broadway.

Comprised entirely of Abba's award-winning hits, the joyous show includes: "Dancing Queen," "Knowing You," "Waterloo," "Money, Money, Money," "The Winner Takes It All," "Mamma Mia", and over a dozen more songs.

Set on the Greek island of Kalokari, the story revolves around Sophie, a young woman engaged to marry her handsome fiancé, Sky. Sophie's mother, Donna, owns an establishment on the idyllic island where she raised Sophie all alone.

Sophie, dreaming of having her father walk her down the aisle, sets out on a mission to discover his identity since her mother has never established who he might be. After reading her mother's diary. Sophie concludes that her dad could be any one of three men and secretly

invites all three to the wedding, expecting to recognize her father instantly.

When everyone arrives for the wedding, there is much reminiscing among Donna's long-time girlfriends, and the three potential fathers. All three men become convinced that they are Sophie's dad, but Sophie has no clue as to which one it is. Undeterred, Sophie decides that her mother should walk her down the aisle. However, before the ceremony begins, Sophie and Sky decide

they are not ready for marriage. Rather than cancel the festivities. Sam, one of the potential fathers, confesses to Donna that he has always loved her, and proposes. Sam and Donna get married and each potential dad agrees that no matter who the real father is, all three with be Sophie's dad.

A movie version came out in 2008, starred Meryl Streep, Pierce Brosnan and Colin Firth and was one of the top films of that year. A film sequel will be released this summer.



ABBA was formed in Stockholm in 1972 by Agnetha Fältskog, Björn Ulvaeus, Benny Andersson, and Anni-Frid Lyngstad and became one of the most commercially successful acts in the history of popular music. Winning the Eurovision Song Contest in 1974 catapulted the group onto an international stage helping to make them one of the best-selling music artists of all time with estimated sales of close to 500 million records. ABBA was the first group from a non-English-speaking country to achieve consistent success in the charts of English-speaking countries.

During the band's active years, the band was composed of two married couples: Fältskog and Ulvaeus, and Lyngstad and Andersson. At the height of their popularity, the band suffered strain which resulted in the collapse of both marriages. These relationship changes were reflected in the group's music, with later compositions

featuring more introspective and dark lyrics.

After ABBA disbanded in December 1982. Andersson and Ulvaeus achieved success writing music for the stage, while Lyngstad and Fältskog pursued solo careers with mixed success. ABBA's music declined in popularity until the purchase of ABBA's catalogue by Polygram in 1989. This enabled the groundwork to be laid for an international re-issue of all their original material and a new Greatest Hits (ABBA Gold) collection in September 1992, which became a worldwide bestseller.

Several films, notably Muriel's Wedding (1994) and The Adventures of Priscilla. Queen of the Desert (1994), further revived interest in the group and spawned several tribute bands. In 1999, ABBA's music was adapted into the successful musical Mamma Mia!

On Monday, February 12th, a ground breaking ceremony was held at Riverside Theatre and at the Star Suites by Riverside Theatre location on the corner of Aviation Blvd. and Flight Safety Drive, near the Vero Beach Regional Airport.

Star Suites by Riverside Theatre, a 60, one-bedroom suite facility, is an enterprise primarily created to accommodate out-of-town actors, designers, directors and artists that work or perform at Riverside Theatre. The project will include a center courtyard, clubhouse, and garden terrace for outside gatherings.

A group of invited contributors, city and county leaders, staff and interested individuals met at the Theatre and were presented with the latest developments and interior designs of the

project. After the presentation in the Theatre's Orchid Lobby, all attendees boarded buses from Magic Carpet Ride and were taken to the site where the official groundbreaking took place.

During select times of the year when rooms are not being used by artists, they will be made available to the public.

It is expected that Star Suites by Riverside Theatre will be open for business by the end of October 2018.

LLW Architects, Inc. of Memphis is the architectural firm that designed the facility with Kimley-Horn serving as the civil engineers and Proctor Construction as construction manager.


