#### A Word from the Education Director

Great things are happening this summer at Riverside Children's Theatre and we want kids of all ages to come and join us as we provide unlimited possibilities to stretch young imaginations and foster growth.

At the Anne Morton Theatre, two family productions highlight the best in kids performing for kids, Magic Tree House: Dinosaurs Before Dark, KIDS and Shrek The Musical. Magic Tree House runs June 14-22 and Shrek the Musical, based on the book by William Steig and the very popular animated film series, Shrek is July 18-27. A Summer Stage '14 treat that is not to be missed.

Beginning Stages camps for ages 4 to 7 showcase a different theme every week featuring fairy tales as the jumping off place for creative expression and fun. Drama, movement, and art are offered daily with a special performance for families at week's end.

iRascals offers 8 to 12 year olds the chance to dive into current pop music with a Rascals Goes Pop show at the end of the two week session.

One-week staged reading workshops give attendees a chance to learn performance skills as participants rehearse and perform a play to be shared with families. Folktales on Stage is the offering for 7 to 11 year olds while the Teen Intensive will tackle a musical, Disney's Mulan, Jr.

For those interested in the technical side, our camp, On Screen, focuses on what it takes to turn ideas into film. Students will be involved from start to finish in the creation of their own short film

Dancers too have their pick of four boot camps to help them hone their skills in ballet, jazz, or tap. The Riverside Dance Festival returns for intermedi ate and advanced dancers and will host artists from the Los Angeles Contemporary Dance Company who will work with students in developing work to be showcased at the end of the two week session.


