MEET our NEW SPECIAL EVENTS Director ANNAMARIE LaBella

As special events director, what do your duties entail?

Conceptualizing, promoting and overseeing the execution of all special events at Riverside Theatre. There are a lot of details and planning that go into pulling off a successful event so you have to be organized. I work with a lot of different vendors, committees, volunteers and staff to make the events come together on event day.

What projects are you working on for the summer?

When I began working for the Theatre, Jon Moses, our Managing Director, met with me about his vision to take our Comedy Zone Experience to the next level. Seven years ago Comedy

Zone started out as an evening comedy club, Jon Moses saw an opportunity to expand on the popularity of the event by adding local live bands as well as a food vendor. This new concept Jon developed really has brought a lot of people to the Theatre that may not usually attend shows. In fact, due to popular demand we



have added additional seating outside to listen to the band and enjoy the food. Jon came to me with the idea to begin theming the weekends as an additional draw to the Theatre. I loved this idea and eagerly began presenting concepts that may work for each theme he developed.

Beginning at the end of May we will kick start our themed weekends with our version of **Summer Nights. We are creating a neighborhood barbecue feel with backyard**

games the whole family can play, our usual live music and everyone's favorite summer grilled items. On select evenings, we will also be featuring a summer wine and beer tasting. In July, we will begin our



Vegas Nights which will have casino-style games to win great prizes, a lounge singer and salsa dancing on Saturday nights in addition to our comedy shows. Donations from this evening will go to benefit Riverside's Children's Theatre Outreach and Family Programming. In September, we will be creating our version of



Oktoberfest offering German-themed food and German music on Saturday nights through October. Over the **holiday season,**



we plan to have the campus decorated with festive lights and maybe even a bit of snow for our Winter Nights.



Anything being planned for the coming season?

There is always a party somewhere! The Riverside Friends Committee and I are already underway planning our fundraising events for next season. Our first one is our annual **Fall Luncheon and Show** which will be held on Thursday, November 19, 2015. Our theme this year is *Riverside Goes to Hollywood!* Once again, Riverside Theatre's Producing Artistic Director, Allen Cornell, and Music Director, Ken Clifton, will be creating the show.

In addition to our Fall Luncheon we are working on our annual **Supper Club** event in January which is also a sell out as well as our **Premiere Benefit Gala** featuring our most anticipated show of the season, *Hello Dolly!* We are also working on revamping the Theatre's corporate membership program for the upcoming season.

This is your second work experience at Riverside. What was the first?

This question makes me smile because I recall sitting in my

college apartment with a bachelor's degree in public relations while minoring in Theatre performance thinking, what am I supposed to do now? With my lease about to expire in a few months, it hit me, maybe I should send my resume to the Executive Director at Riverside Theatre. As luck would have it, they were looking to expand their marketing department and I was offered a position as the Marketing Assistant. What a wild time that was for not only me but also Riverside – the Theatre was in the middle of a huge Capital Campaign project to expand the Theatre while continuing to be a quality professional theatre to the Treasure Coast. Needless to say, I had to hit the ground running. It was during that time that I realized I wanted to seek more experience in the world of Special Events.

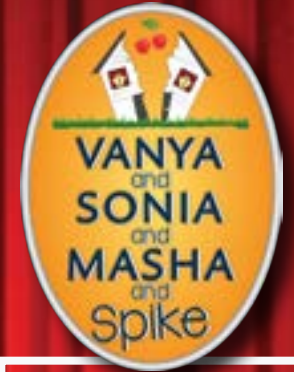

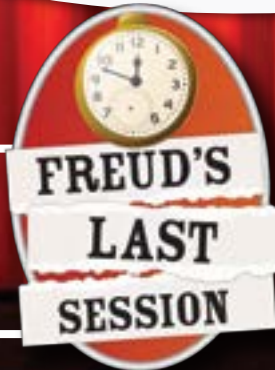

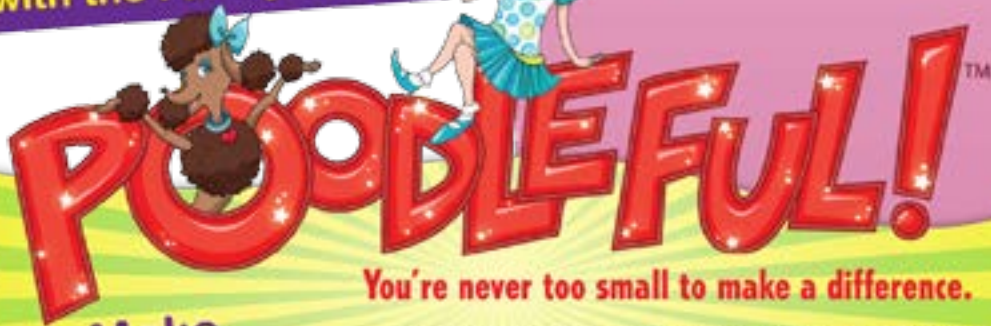

Lots of changes are in store at Riverside Children's Theatre this summer but the one constant is a variety of offerings that give kids the opportunity to become engaged in the arts. Having fun while learning new skills and reinforcing what is taught at school is at the heart of Riverside Children's Theatre (RCT) – all this plus a welcoming environment and a generous scholarship program that ensures a place for all children, no matter their ability to pay.

An exciting start to the summer is the *Lion King Experience*, bringing an age appropriate adaptation of the Broadway hit *The Lion King* to the Anne Morton stage. Another Disney favorite, *High School Musical* will be rehearsed as an intense two-week camp and will present a concert version in July.

New this summer is Kinder Camp, an introduction to theatre and music that helps promote language development and socialization skills. Beginning Stages Camp is back this year with every week having a different theme. *iRascals* returns with an expanded format so that more kids than ever can join in on the fun with a *Rascals Goes Pop* show at the end of each session. Two sessions of staged reading workshops offer kids a reader's theatre format with a chance to perform while enhancing their reading comprehension.

The Riverside Dance Festival returns and features artists from the Chicago Repertory Ballet. Finally, Dance Brush Up Camps right before school starts will give young dancers a chance to ready jazz and ballet skills prior to fall classes and auditions.

For the fourth year in a row, late summer means contemporary dance comes to Riverside. Featuring a student intensive, outreach initiative, and collaboration with Ballet Vero Beach, the Riverside Dance Festival returns July 27-August 9. Festival Director Adam Schnell has selected Chicago's hot, new, contemporary ballet company Chicago Repertory Ballet (CRB) as the invited company for this year's festival. Schnell chose the company because, while dancing professionally, he performed work by CRB's artistic director Wade Schaaf. "Wade brings an intellect to choreography much like audiences saw with Kate Hutter's work last year for Los Angeles Contemporary Dance Company (LACDC), yet his style is completely different. We are thrilled to be presenting CRB for their first time outside Chicago."

As with LACDC in 2014 and Prometheus Dance in 2013, CRB will be in residence at Riverside for two full weeks. The company will take the lead in coaching young dancers aged ten and up in what it takes to be a professional dancer. Accepted students will spend eight hours a day in classes, rehearsals, and workshops with CRB dancers and artistic staff, as well as Riverside's distinguished dance faculty, in preparation for a fully staged showcase performance on the Stark Stage.
